

Internal regulations for students

1. Students are obliged to participate in all lectures, seminars and exercises.
2. Three absences from classes are allowed during the academic year.
3. A student who is absent from more than 3 classes must take an additional intermediate exam to be eligible for the final exam.
3. At the seminars students should have a basic knowledge on the seminar topics (based on lectures and textbooks).
4. Seminars start with a short entrance test consisting of 5 multiple choice questions related to the seminar's topic.
5. A student who is late for a seminar will obtain zero points from the entrance test.
6. A student must score at least 50% plus 1 point to be eligible for the intermediate exam (an average from all seminars in a thematic block). Students who do not meet this criterion will be given an unsatisfactory mark for the intermediate and will have to take the retake exam.
7. Students may retake each intermediate exam twice.
8. A student has to pass all the intermediate exams to become eligible for the final exam.
9. The course ends with the final exam in the (MCQ) format. Intermediate exams and retakes may be oral or written or both.
